Learning Goals for This Week

Language Arts

- Blending words (orally combining beginning, middle, and end sounds to create a word)
- Segmenting words (orally breaking words into their beginning, middle, and end sounds)
- Writing the letter and recognizing/producing the sounds of lowercase letters: i, e, l
- Reading and writing the sight words: get, said, be
- Reading, cutting apart, and gluing together sentences with sight words
- Using one-to-one correspondence when following text in a book and when trying to read (pointing to only one word being read at a time)
- Following along with and beginning to read simple repetitive passages, nursery rhymes, and books
- Using sight words they know to write and sounding out words to write
- Reciting and reading nursery rhymes and chart poems
- Writing to an audience (We wrote thank you notes to Mrs. Cochrane for guest teaching!)

Math

- Counting by 1s and 10s to 100
- Writing and identifying teen numbers
- Naming, recognizing, and describing 3-Dimensional shapes in the real world
- Using numbers of vertices and faces to identify 3-Dimensional shapes
- Playing shape identification matching games with a partner or group

Social Studies: Please see the letter and the calendar in the BEE Book about February being Kindness Month for our school. Using kind words and actions continues to be a goal for our class so please help your child participate in these wonderful activities!

Science:

- We have been working on identifying seasons and the related weather and clothing for each season.
